## About the Property

People's Place is a new development of 69 one-, two- and three-bedroom units, which will serve households earning 30-60% of the area median income (AMI). The property will also have 21 units set aside for farmworker households making 30-45% of the AMI.

All units will be equipped with a new refrigerator, stove, dishwasher, window coverings, and vinyl flooring. On-site amenities include a community building and kitchen for resident events, outdoor courtyards, shared gardens, designated bike storage, onsite uncovered parking, and playgrounds. All residents will have access to free, confidential supportive services.
